As of May 23, Governor DeSantis has signed only 16 of the 194 bills passed in the 2020 legislative session. The rest remain with the Legislators until the Governor is not as preoccupied with the COVID 19 pandemic. The 93.2 billion dollar budget remains unsigned.

events and activities.


The drop down menu from the Top-Nav allows you to go directly to the page you want to access.
