League of Women Voters to host Zoom program on national popular vote

National Popular Voter Interstate Compact has become law in 17 states and the District of Columbia. These jurisdictions have 209 of the 270 electoral votes needed to activate the law that would guarantee the presidency to the candidate who receives the most popular votes nationwide.

Florida lawmakers have filed new bills in the House and Senate that would enter the state into the compact.

On Tuesday, Feb. 10 at 7 p.m., the League of Women Voters of The Villagers/Tri-County will host a Zoom presentation featuring Dr. Anne Coppenhaver from Floridians for National Popular Vote. Dr. Coppenhaver will discuss the issues her organization sees with the current winner-take-all system and propose a solution that does not require amending the Constitution.
