## LWV offers overview of 2026 Florida Constitutional Amendments

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The League of Women Voters of The Villages/Tri County Florida (LWVTRIFL) will review the three constitutional amendments appearing on Florida's November ballot during its general meeting at 2 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 10. All three measures involve budgets: one at the state level and two at the local level.

The impact of passing an amendment can be more complex than it first appears. The presentation will explain how each of these proposed amendments, if approved, could affect the daily lives of Florida residents for years to come.

The public is welcome to attend. The event will be at the Fruitland Park Library. Seating is limited; doors open to members at 1:30 p.m. and to the public at 1:45 p.m.
