Thanks to so many of you that have stepped forward to do the work of this group. We continue to grow and welcome you to join us and become involved.


Enjoy the “spring” weather and hope to see you at the Annual Meeting. Bring a friend!

### **Voter Registration Credentials**

Just a reminder to League members who are certified to register voters, as well as League members who would like to be certified to register voters, please note that as of **December 31, 2018**, the certification of all voter registrars expired. League members who do voter registration for the League will need to re-certify their credentials with the State League **ASAP**. Beginning in 2017 the LWVFL instituted a 2-year cycle whereby the list of approved voter registrars would be wiped clean, requiring members to re-certify. The two-year cycle ended on 12/31/2018.

If you are planning to do any voter registration you must study the PowerPoint which is on the LWV Florida website and take the quiz, attaining a perfect score. Once you pass with 100% you will get a notification from LWVFL that you are authorized to do voter registration. ### **Education**

The legislative session starts on March 5, and education appears in the sights of our senators and representatives. Among the proposed legislation are:

- A bill to expand the school “guardian” program to allow trained classroom teachers to be armed. A state commission created last year recommended allowing armed teachers;
- A bill to fund a new category of private school vouchers with a pot of money typically reserved for public schools.

With regard to Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) which has been an issue for our League for the last 4 years, and which we have a position on, members of the VPK team visited with Sen. Baxkley and Rep. Hage to bring them up-to-date our work and left with them a one page summary outlining the need for an investment in this valuable program which is offered free to all 4 year olds in Florida.
